The Great Victorian Cherry Trail

The Great Victorian Cherry Trail is a brochure produced by the Victorian Cherry Association to promote growers throughout Victoria where consumers can visit and either “*pick your own*” or purchase ready picked Cherries.

The Victorian cherry season starts in early November and continues through until early January. The peak season is in the weeks leading up to Christmas.

Victoria’s cherry growers have rich soils and a moderate climate in order to grow the best cherries for the consumer to enjoy. Most growers have 10 or more varieties which mature throughout the season. Each week one or more varieties are usually available.
